

Plumber

The Alameda County General Services Agency is seeking a temporary **Plumber** in the Building Maintenance Department to perform the work of a journey-level plumber including installing, maintaining, and repairing gas, steam, plumbing and related fixtures, pipes, and fittings in structures; and to do other related work as required.

Example of Duties:

- ◇ Designs and installs plumbing systems for minor remodeling projects in accordance with applicable codes. Performs corrective and preventive maintenance on all types of plumbing systems and components.
- ◇ Installs water service piping and taps water and sewer mains and laterals.
- ◇ Installs and repairs steam and hot water systems and renews pipes, valves, and fittings.
- ◇ Repairs and replaces valves, fittings, ball-cocks, and other fixtures; cuts and threads pipe; packs faucets; repairs water supply, waste, and drainage pipes.
- ◇ Cleans out drains and obstructions in water and sewer systems.
- ◇ Maintains appropriate records pertaining to work schedules, log of shift operations and meter readings, and inventory.

- ◇ Work location is in San Leandro, California (but must be willing and able to travel throughout Alameda County).

Minimum Qualifications:

- ◇ Five years' experience as a Plumber.
- ◇ Possession of a valid California Motor Vehicle Operator's license.
- ◇ Possession of a valid Backflow Preventer Testing Certificate.
- ◇ Must be able to obtain and maintain a Security Site Clearance.
